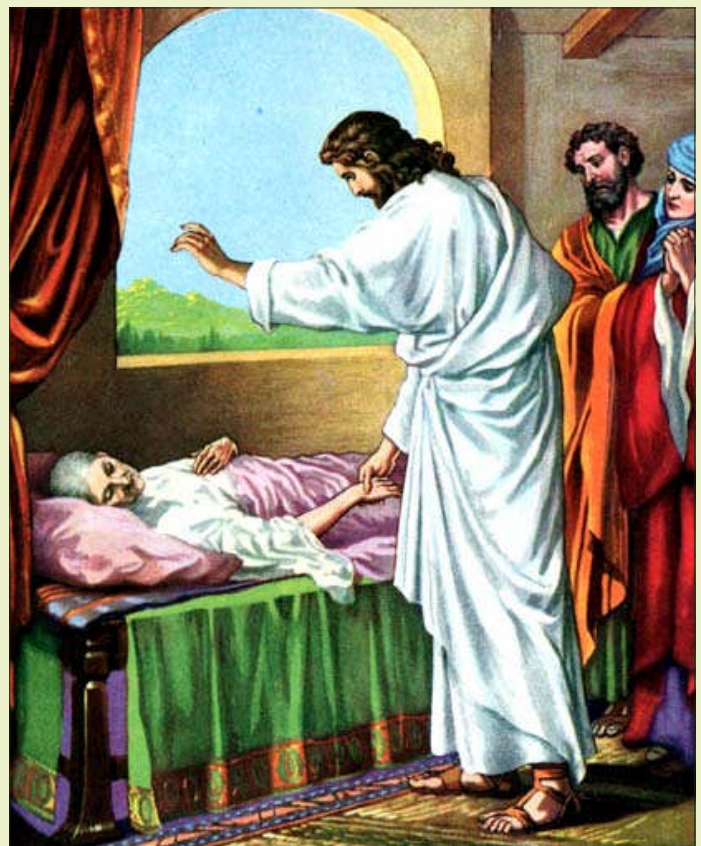

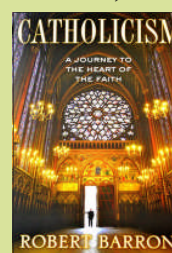
VALENTINE LUNCHEON / CARD PARTY

Fr. Scott will give the homily at all weekend Masses on Feb. 18 and 19, including the 5 PM Family Mass on Sunday evening. He will celebrate Mass on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday at 8 AM, followed by a 20-minute talk on *The Power of Prayer*, with a different aspect each morning. An evening service will begin at 7 PM, Saturday through Wednesday. The themes of the talks are *A Christian Response to Stress*, on Sunday evening, *Celebrating our Families* on Monday, *Finding True Happiness* on Tuesday, and *The Art of Forgiveness* on Ash Wednesday. The service will include a scripture reading, Mission talk by Father Scott, quiet time, hymns and prayers. Services will end around 8:30 PM.

As in past Missions, all parish programs will be cancelled during the Mission. This makes the Parish Mission the primary focus and allows all parishioners to be attend the Mission.

CELEBRATE YOUR MARRIAGE!

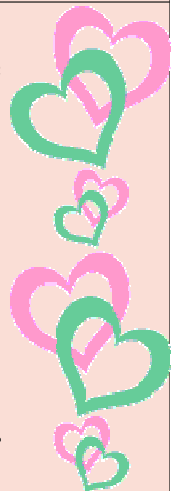
In February, there are many ways to celebrate your marriage!

Greetings Once Again

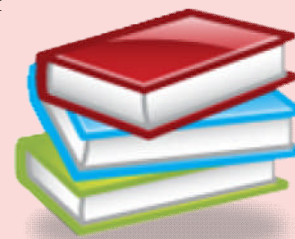
Open House was great! I hope many of you were able to come by to see how we are progressing. If you did not get a chance, then stop by for a tour at any time. We love to show off our school.
