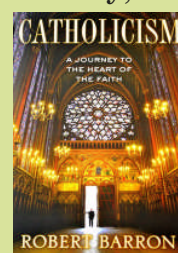
IS GOD CALLING YOU?

FIRST FRIDAY OF FEBRUARY

This coming Friday is a special day loaded with meaning for us Catholics. You may recognize February 3 as St. Blaise Day, the occasion when we all go forward to have our throats blessed. St. Blaise, a bishop who was martyred in the 4th century, saved a boy who was choking on a fish bone. Now we call upon his intercession to bless our throats for the coming year. We will have the ceremony at our 8 AM Mass this Friday.

For many centuries, the first Friday of each month holds a day of popular devotion related to the Sacred Heart of Christ. Following a promise to St. Margaret Mary in the 17th century, receiving communion on nine consecutive first Fridays grants the grace of final repentance. Many of the devout don't stop with nine months, but they continue their devotion to the Sacred Heart and the promise received by Margaret Mary by attending Mass on the first Friday of each month.

Friday at St. Catherine Parish is the weekly school Mass, and this Friday our 75 school children will be celebrating their faith and having their throats blessed, also at the 8 AM Mass.

The Council of Catholic Women holds the intentions of the same Mass. The organization's members are asked to come worship together, praying especially for their living and deceased members. You will see them in the first few pews on the left of the church.
