

## Description of Positions

- Ciborium:
- 1 - Center
  - 2 - Blessed Virgin side (front)
  - 3 - St. Joseph side (front)
  - 4 - Begin on Blessed Virgin side (back)
  - 5 - Begin on St. Joseph side (back)
  - 6 - Begin in Chapel
  - 7 - Middle aisle (in front of glass doors)
  - 7, 8 - Holy Days – both in middle aisle (in front of glass doors)

- Cups
- 1C EM with the Host at Position 3 is against the west wall. You are at the other end of the pew. When finished, stand by the organ next to Cup Bearer #2.
  - 2C Stand at far end of organ.
  - 3C Follow presider when he gives the Host to people in handicapped pew, offering them the Precious Blood. Then stand at end of railing by the Tabernacle, facing the middle aisle.
  - 4C Head towards Host Position 2, stand with your back to Cup Bearer 3C, facing east wall. When finished, turn and stand next to Cup Bearer 3C, facing middle aisle, helping him/her with communicants coming from middle aisle.

Consume any Precious Blood you have left in your Cup, in the Sanctuary, and NOT in the aisle.

When you give the Host and Precious Blood in the Choir section, make sure you wait until Rob and the Choir members end the hymn so they can receive from you.

## NEW NOTES

If are a Eucharistic Minister (EM). The Liturgy Committee has decided that we will revert back to a former guideline, where each person serves in one ministry per Mass. Also, please do not schedule yourself as an Usher when you are a Lector or EM, thus keeping reverence to the Word of the Lord and the Eucharist, and also to give others an opportunity to minister. If you are a Sacristan, your ministry is before and after Mass, meaning you may have one ministry during Mass.

There are no cup bearers scheduled at 8:00 Masses on the holy days because the school children will be present at those Masses and we haven't begun to offer the Precious Blood at the children's Masses yet. Dr. Anna wants them to be catechized before we do, and this may not be until January.

You will notice some of the people who prefer 10:30 Mass have been scheduled at other Masses. It is the only way we could cover all Masses.
