

NOTES for EUCHARISTIC MINISTERS

Positions: #1 – Center #2 – Blessed Virgin side (Front) #3 – St. Joseph side (Front)
 #4 – Begin on Blessed Virgin side (Back) #5 – Begin on St.; Joseph side
(Back)
 #6 – Begin in Chapel #7 – Begin at the end of the middle aisle, turned
around facing the Altar

Positions #2 & #4 go to the Tabernacle. When a deacon is present, he goes to the Tabernacle. When you are #2, check before Mass to see if there is a deacon and if so, check the Tabernacle to see if there are three or more ciboria. If so, #2 will help the deacon when he goes to the Tabernacle for the Eucharist. After Communion, if there are three or more ciboria on the Altar to be taken to the Tabernacle, #2 will help him.

“V” - This person is unable to serve this weekend.

“--“ - This person is a Lector, so will be unable to substitute as a Eucharistic Minister.

Thank you for getting your own substitute when you can't keep your commitment.
