### LECTOR #1

- When Father comes out of the Sacristy, begin the announcements. (This only occurs before the 7:30 AM Mass. Rob will make the announcements before all other weekend Masses.)
- Proclaim the first reading.

### LECTOR #2

- Carry the Book of Gospels in procession when no deacon is present.
- Proclaim the second reading.
- Read the Prayers of the Faithful from the Ambo when no deacon is present

### Comments to those who are scheduled to read the Passion of our Lord:

Lector #1 will proclaim the first reading. When Lector #2 is finishing the second reading, Lector #1 goes to the podium to be ready to be the “Voice” in the reading of the Passion. Lector #2 will read the Prayers of the Faithful unless a deacon is present.

Deacon Max is the Narrator at 7:30 Mass. Deacon Jim is the Narrator at 9:00 Mass. Narrators are scheduled at 3:30V, 5:00V, 10:30 AM and 5:00 PM Masses. Those Narrators go to the ambo as the Lector descends after the second reading. Father will read the part of Jesus from the Altar. Since the Narrator is the first to speak, look at Father, then at the Speaker, to be sure that they are ready. Take your time – read slowly and distinctly. If you need a substitute or if you have any questions, please call me.
